

# Minutes of the Eleventh International Hebrew Christian Conference of the International Hebrew Christian Alliance

Held at Stuttgart, Germany,  
7th August, 1963.

**T**HE Conference convened at 9.15 a.m., the President, Dr. Jakob Jocz, in the chair.

1. Worship was conducted by the Rev. Ernst Loewy.
2. Delegates from Great Britain, America, Denmark, Germany, Holland, South Africa, Argentina, Australia and Iran presented their credentials.
3. A draft revised Constitution was submitted and examined. It was moved, seconded and resolved that this Constitution be approved and adopted. The delegate of the Dutch Alliance asked that her vote to the contrary be recorded.
4. It was moved, seconded and resolved that the Finance and General Purposes Committee be requested to consider the possibility of making such verbal

changes in Article VIII of the Constitution and Article III of the By-Laws as would without any alteration of doctrine or principle bring the statements more into line with the wording of the historic creeds; such changes, if agreed upon, to be sent to affiliated Alliances twelve months before the next Ordinary Conference.

5. It was moved, seconded and resolved that the Finance and General Purposes Committee be requested to prepare a booklet setting out the aims of the Alliance from its inception, explaining the Constitution, and recording important pronouncements made from time to time.
6. The minutes of the day's proceedings were read and confirmed.
7. The President pronounced the Benediction and the Conference concluded.
