Minutes of Extraordinary Conference
held at Sunbury Court Conference Centre on Thursday,
25th October, 1990

Present:

Also present but without right of speech or vote were other members of the Executive Committee and Finance and General Purposes Committee which preceded the Conference.

The President opened the Conference with Scripture reading and the Revd. T. H. Bendor-Samuel and Mr. Paul Liberman led in prayer.

2. The Extraordinary Conference was specially convened in order to consider the proposal of the Messianic Jewish Alliance of America that:-

The name of this fellowship shall be the International
Messianic Jewish Alliance.

This being a controversial matter it was agreed that voting should be by secret ballot.

Mr. Paul Liberman made the proposal on behalf of the American Alliance, and Mr. Haim Levi seconded the motion.

3. The Revd. Harcourt Samuel informed Conference that the Hebrew Christian Alliance of Great Britain wished to propose an amendment:-

The name of this fellowship shall be the International
Messianic Jewish (Hebrew Christian) Alliance.

The amendment was seconded by Mr. Tom Lori.

4. Miss Justina Lofty and Mrs. Alison Bendor-Samuel were appointed scrutineers.

Result of ballot:-

That the amendment be the substantive motion

Against	7

5. Mrs. Robyn Gunsberger proposed a further amendment purely on the grounds of logo design, but after discussion this was withdrawn, and the substantive motion put to the vote.

Result of ballot:-

For	18
Against	8

6. The President closed the Conference by reading Psalm 121 and prayer. This was followed by all joining in unison in the Lord's Prayer.
