International LCJE Report 1994

This year's report is going to be a short one. I am only going to mention one thing, for I assume that LCJE members keep abreast of what goes on in LCJE through our quarterly Bulletin. Those who are not already members can become members in connection with this meeting!

I want to look ahead - towards the Jerusalem conference in 1995.

In LCJE's short history there have before been plans to have an international LCJE conference in Israel. For various reasons it has failed so far. But now LCJE's Fifth International Conference has been scheduled for 18–23 June 1995. The premises of the conference will be a hotel on the outskirts of Jerusalem – the name, however, will not appear in the Bulletin. I would like to see what sources the anti-missionaries have – apart from our Bulletin!

At the end of April I shall be settling the practical matters with our agent in Israel – a Messianic Jew, by the way. When the members of LCJE's International Coordinating Committee visited the place, we were very specific about making it clear to the manager of the hotel who we were. He had only one comment: I am a business man!

The conference is an LCJE conference on Jewish Evangelism. That means that LCJE does not sponsor Jewish Evangelism during the conference.

In various ways the conference will have a distinct flavour of Zion. At the morning sessions we shall devote our time to themes from The Acts of the Apostles – the themes will be treated in a "then" perspective and a "now" perspective.

At the evening sessions we shall focus on Jesus and his ministry – particularly around and in Jerusalem.

Three afternoons there will be outdoor seminars, where we walk or drive to places in the Jerusalem area with relevance to Jewish Evangelism also today. And one other afternoon there will be approximately eight different indoor seminars to choose among. And of course reports on Jewish Evangelism all over the world are also part of the conference – as are business meetings!

The price for the conference will be approximately USD 500 per person. This amount includes accommodation in double room, all meals and conference fee. For non-members the price will be slightly higher. As in Zeist – the papers will be published in booklets – which are also included in the price.

In continuation of the conference the participants will be offered a tour of Galilee, 23–26 June. This will not be an ordinary tourist trip, the program will be targeted on Jewish Evangelism. Several talks and lectures are included.

I have made a slip which I would like you to fill out. It will give us some idea of how many will attend the conference. Those who register first – a binding registration will not be necessary till the printed program appears some time in August 1994 – can be sure of a hotel room on the premises. If attendance becomes bigger than expected, we shall also manage to find room for the extra number.

As International Coordinator I want to thank you for your encouragement and support and prayers.
